



Youth Pig Project Application Form

The Wisconsin Pork Association Youth Committee developed the Youth Pig Project scholarship program to assist youth in developing pork production projects for 4-H and FFA members with the intent of educating youth on developing life skills and career opportunities available within the Wisconsin pork industry.

4-H/FFA youth ages 9-19 as of January 1st are eligible to receive a \$50.00 scholarship used to offset the costs associated with their pig project for the 2010 show season. Winners will be contacted by the WI Pork Association and asked to appear at the WPA Futurity Sale to receive their award.

Five (5) \$50.00 scholarships will be awarded. Also, an additional \$25 will be awarded to the pig project recipients if they purchase a pig at the WPA futurity sale. Age divisions are as follows: Ages 9-12, 13-15, 16-19 (Age as of January 1st). Total number of scholarships awarded will be based on the number of entries submitted by the March 15th deadline.

Youth who receive a WPA Youth Pig Project Scholarship will receive a follow-up questionnaire after their project year is complete. We at the WI Pork Association are interested in how this program made a difference in your 4-H or FFA career involvement!
