

## PRRS/PEDv Testing Rebate Program



The Wisconsin Pork Association offers two tiers of rebates to producers testing for Porcine Reproductive and Respiratory Syndrome (PRRS) and Porcine Epidemic Diarrhea Virus (PEDv).

- Tier 1: \$25 rebate to pork producers to help offset ELISA testing costs.
- Tier 2: \$100 rebate to pork producers to offset PCR testing costs.
  - For tests completed April 1<sup>st</sup>- December 1<sup>st</sup>, 2023.

Testing is required to comply with Wisconsin's Animal Health rule effective March 2018. The rule requires farms with pigs to test for PRRS and PEDv when moving intrastate or interstate. Testing is not required for pigs moving directly to harvest. The funding is available on a first come-first serve basis. **Producers may apply for one grant per premises per quarter per year.** All rebates must be received by December 1, 2023.

### The following requirements and stipulations apply:

- Producer must complete and submit rebate form by December 1<sup>st</sup>, 2023.
- Reimbursement form must include documentation showing proof of test completion
  - Proof of test includes a dated copy of a veterinary clinic bill that shows a line item for PRRS/ PEDv testing and a copy of a test report including date and results from a veterinary diagnostic lab. Producers requesting \$100 rebate must include if pigs have been vaccinated.
